2011 A Capella Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir is a favorite grape to grow and vinify for winemaker Lee Lutes. This particular wine demonstrates how well suited the varietal is to our unique Old Mission Peninsula microclimate. The finest Pinot Noir grapes from the Capella and Montana Russo Vineyards have been selected and blended to make this wine.

Vintage Overview

2011 was a strong vintage producing high quality wines. The warm and extended growing degree days allowed for more maturation of the red grapes including Pinot Noir.

Flavor & Aroma

Aromas of black currants and deep barrel spice are followed by blackberry and dark cherry fruit flavors. This is a fragrant and spice-driven red that is complimented by an elegant oak finish.

Aging Potential

Proper cellaring will reward the patient in ten plus years.

Pinot Noir tends to be one of the most versatile red wines and is often a wonderful addition to many meals. Some of our recommendations include: grilled herb crusted lamb or salmon, portobella mushroom burgers as well as mild and creamy cheeses.
