This wine is stellar now but, with appropriate cellaring, will develop exceptionally during the next three to ten plus years.

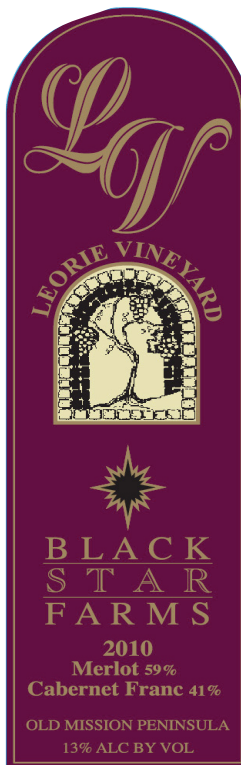
Thoughts for Food
