This Pinot Gris, like most of our white wines from 2012, is really showing off the superb quality of the vintage. There is lush fruit on both the nose and the palate, there is body that comes from well developed fruit and there is a lingering finish that simply begs for food.

2012 was a strong vintage producing high quality aromatic white wines. This Pinot Gris from our 7 Hills Vineyard on the Old Mission Peninsula appellation is crisp and refreshing with a fabulous fruit profile and balanced acidity.
