Red House Red

This red is a vibrant blend of five different varieties with Cabernet Franc as the main component. Merlot, Pinot Noir, and the French-American varieties-Foch and Regent-have minority roles in the blend, giving this wine a pleasant balance between ripe red fruit and earthy rusticity. This is a perfect table red for anything off the grill and for hearty pastas.

Vintage Overview

Our Red House wines are non vintage specific as they are often made from a blend of different grapes. High quality fruit is always sourced and blended into each batch.

Flavor & Aroma

The ruby color of this wine is striking! It has a solid, medium body and fresh red fruit aromas (raspberry) and an herbaceous bell pepper aspect. There are marked oak flavors including vanilla spice.

Aging Potential

This wine is stellar now but, with appropriate cellaring, will develop exceptionally during the next three to five plus years.

The pizza wine! Any tomato based sauce, cooked or uncooked will be a perfect match to the nice acidity, good texture and fruity character of our house red.
