



## 2013 Arcturos Pinot Noir

**Tasting Notes:** This Pinot Noir has aromas of violets and plums followed by fruit forward flavors of dark cherries, currants and complementary oak in the finish. There is a balance of vibrant fruit and spicy complexity that comes from time in the barrel. Oak used for this bottling is mostly older, roughly 10-15% new and French.

**Residual Sugar:** 0%

**Varietals:** 100% Pinot Noir

**Vineyard Source:** Leelanau Summit, Montana Rusa, and Isidor's Choice; 62% Leelanau Peninsula, 38 % Old Mission Peninsula

**Kind of Oak:** new and older French oak

**Time in Oak:** 18 months

**Malolactic Fermentation:** 100%
