



2013 Arcturos Semi-Dry Riesling

Tasting Notes: A classic, off-dry Riesling with wonderfully ripe, rich stone fruit flavors of pear, peach and apricot. Finishes with a crisp and refreshing acidity.

Residual Sugar: 1.65%

Varietals: 100% Riesling

Vineyard Source: Montana Rusa, Montague Estate and Capella vineyards; 79% Leelanau Peninsula, 21% Old Mission Peninsula

Winemaker's Notes: "2013 produced one of the best growing seasons for Riesling in 5 + years with a bounty of ripe fruit and acid to complement and balance. This 2013 Semi-Dry is (perhaps) the best Riesling of this style we've made to date, and it's not only due to the growing season but also the input from one of our newer vineyard plantings that was hitting its stride for the first time in that year. This is a vineyard at the Leelanau Summit site that was planted to multiple Riesling clones and does the job of enhancing the depth of flavor and aroma in this beautiful wine. It is both floral and fruit forward, and is one to put away for 5 plus years, as good cellaring will reward the patient with enhanced complexity and depth. I'd actually like to see this wine in 10-15 years and believe it will easily live that long."
