

## 2016 Arcturos Pinot Noir Rosé

**Tasting Notes:** Made from grapes grown on Leelanau (44%) and Old Mission (56%) peninsulas, this dry rosé has bright aromas of fresh strawberries, delicate fruit flavors with a subtle minerality and a crisp, clean finish. We suggest this lovely wine with salads, light pastas, and seafood -especially grilled salmon, shrimp, and lobster.
