

2016 Arcturos Pinot Gris

Tasting Notes: Complex yet refreshing, this opulent white wine has citrus, melon and delicate floral notes followed by subtle minerality and balanced acidity. An excellent food wine that pairs wonderfully with seafood, in particular shellfish.

Varietals: 96% Pinot Gris, 4% Pinot Blanc

Harvest Dates: September 27 – September 30, 2016 **Winemaking:** Stainless steel, no malolactic fermentation

Residual Sugar: .4%

Alcohol: 13.1%

Cases Produced: 2006

Winemakers' Comments: The winemaking team at Black Star Farms prefers the richer "Alsatian style" of Pinot Gris over the leaner Italian style of Pinot Grigio, hence this wine shows big fruit, a luscious mouth feel, but still maintains a dry finish.
