Fruit is sourced from both the proprietor's vineyards and those of local grower partners on the Old Mission and Leelanau Peninsulas. This diversity allows us to obtain consistent quality across vintages.

Winemaker Comments

You are either a Gewürztraminer fan or not, but you know it when you taste one you like. This vintage has everything we favor in this spicy white while avoiding the cloying richness that often makes these wines too heady. This wine was sourced from vines cloned from the Manigold vineyard, one of the Old Mission Peninsula's best vineyards for this variety.

Tasting Notes

This dry white rewards its drinkers with layered complexity in both aroma and flavor. Look forward to aromas of crushed rose petals and peach blossoms laced with pink peppercorns, followed by flavors of lychee and ripe Asian pear interwoven with hints of grated ginger.

Thoughts for Food

Middle Eastern fare like kebabs, dishes that feature aromatic herbs like ginger, clove, or cinnamon, and traditional roasted turkey.
